## LISTEN = SILENCE



ABOVE: The 4th grade class conducted an experiment to practice the scientific method. They used milk, food coloring, and dish soap. They developed questions and hypothesized what would happen. After developing a hypothesis, they conducted the experiment, recorded and analyzed their data. They found that the molecules in the milk reacted with the dish soap. Which, in turn, made the food coloring swirl and burst in the plate! Awesome! **<u>RIGHT:</u>** Middle school with Mrs. Stephanie Love, a Forester and Certified Silviculturist for the USDA. Mrs. Love talked to the middle school about a variety of things including photosynthesis, what trees need to survive. and Deciduous Forests.



To the right: Middle school students are doing a paper towel experiment. The purpose of this lab was to figure out which paper towel is the strongest. The students used the Scientific Method as a standard format to ask questions, gather information, make a hypothesis, conduct the experiment, observe and record results, and share results in their conclusion.








To the LEFT: Mrs. Stone's 5th grade class is growing mold!! Be on the lookout for updated photo's in next month's news letter.
