Huntsville Police Sergeant Tess Hughes, a supervising officer in the precinct that serves the area that includes the Islamic Academy and masjid, will provide an in-service for teachers on keeping our students safe. Sgt. Hughes will also do a walk-through of our school, masjid, and grounds with the IAH principal and the teacher in charge of safety, Mrs. Cook (who was a safety officer when she served in the U.S. Army), to see if there is anything we can do to improve the security of our building and grounds. Alhamdulillah, thanks to God for such good community resources! School will be half day and students will be dismissed at 11:45 on that Thursday. It is vital for you to pick up your students on time.


